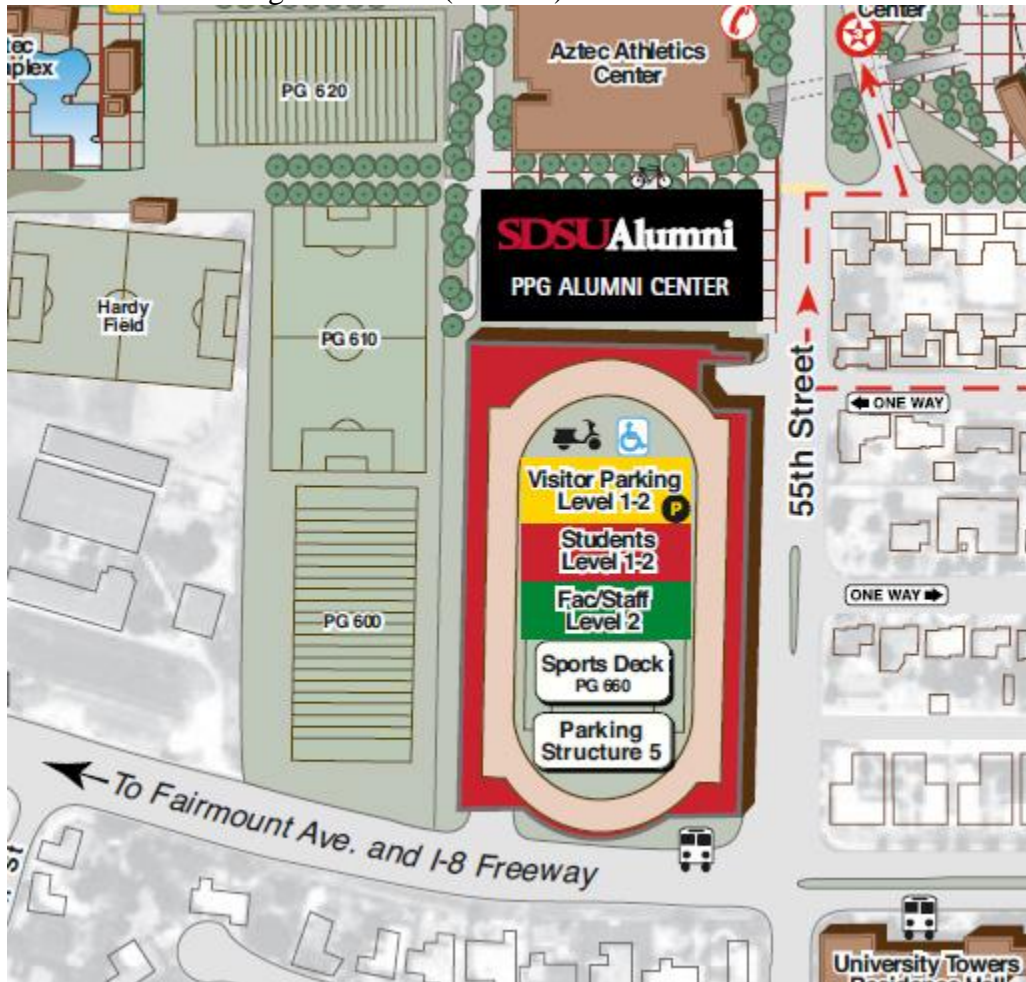

## Directions

**From Interstate 8-East**, take the Mission Gorge Road/Fairmount Avenue exit. Travel south on Fairmount Avenue. Bear right and take the Montezuma Road exit. Turn left at 55th Street. Turn left into Parking Structure 5 (Aztrack).

**From Interstate 8-West**, take the College Avenue exit and proceed south. Turn right at Montezuma Road and proceed past Campanile Drive. Turn right at 55th Street. Turn left into Parking Structure 5 (Aztrack).
