Data and Procedures for CVUSD Families Identifying as Homeless Miguel Gavillan, CVUSD Educational Services, Program Liaison, Homeless/Foster, Professional Development and TEDx Kids, spoke to the group about the count of families that identified themselves as homeless this past school year. The schools with the highest number of students were Johnson, Madison, Montgomery Middle School and Cajon Valley Middle. There were 341 families identified who were staying in motels, licensed children’s institutes, temporary sharing, unsheltered or sheltered. He also spoke with the group on the process for identifying a family and the services available to them. He was interested in the resource guides, the summer lunch tabling program and holding a resource fair at a high-risk school in the fall.</p>	No action required.
